A Word *from* Your Pulpit Supply Committee

The Pulpit Supply Committee would like to bring an update to you on our activities and where we feel that God is leading us beginning in the month of January. The Supply Committee continues to meet together on a regular basis, and our intent is to stay between two and three months ahead in the scheduling of speakers for Wednesday nights, Sunday mornings and Sunday nights. Our task has been humbling, as we understand that we must move in accordance with what we feel God is asking us to do in His time and on His terms. As hard as it may be, the Supply Committee must separate our own preferences and opinions and that of other members and earnestly seek God's will for our church during this interim period. Through much prayer we feel that we are being led to move forward with the following supply structures as much as we possibly can.

Wednesday nights-We will continue to move forward as we have over the past few months, using men from our congregation to teach God's Word to the faithful that are able to attend prayer service. It is our intent, as much as the individuals' schedules allow, to have them teach in consecutive weeks, which will give them ample opportunity to share the message that God has revealed to them.

Sunday Nights-The Pulpit Supply Committee feels strongly that God has raised up men at

First Baptist Church of Tupelo who are gifted communicators, but more importantly, who are eager and capable of sharing the Gospel. We will continue to invite FBC members to speak for the majority of Sunday evening services, while understanding special circumstances may dictate other speakers to be scheduled. God is doing a great work in utilizing and speaking through our members, and we invite you to come and hear their messages on Sunday nights at FBC of Tupelo.

Sunday Morning-The Pulpit Supply Committee has extended the invitation to Dr. Todd Brady to continue in his current role to fill the pulpit at all three services on Sunday mornings. Dr. Brady has done a tremendous job teaching and bringing a divinely inspired message to God's people at FBC of Tupelo. Our full time ministerial staff will continue to provide pastoral care to the congregation and minister to spiritual and physical needs as they arise within the membership. We have committed to Dr. Brady to supply FBC's Sunday morning pulpit needs through April, pending God's timing with our Senior Pastor search process. There are a few Sundays that he will be away with personal or professional commitments, and the committee has made arrangements for those dates. There will be additional special Sundays where other speakers will be invited to lead our congregation in worship, and more information will be forthcoming about those dates as it becomes available.

Please feel free to contact any of the committee members with questions. We do covet your prayers during this process, just as the Pastor Search Committee does. We are humbled to be able to serve God in this capacity and to serve First Baptist Church of Tupelo.

READING GOD'S WORD

It is a great joy to see how our church family is joining together to pray for our pastor search process. There is great strength in our being focused on God's leadership as one body. Another way we can grow and be drawn together is by reading God's Word together. As we begin 2015 we are going to be reading the Bible through chronologically. These last two years we have taken a slower walk straight through the Scriptures. This year we are going to read it as it happened and will happen. We invite all our church to join us in reading God's Word through in 2015. Reading plan sheets will be available outside the Sanctuary and at the Welcome Center. The plan will be posted here in the Evangel and will be available on the church website, fbctupelo.org.

As we begin this new year in reading God's Word, here are some suggestions to help us all stay with it and see this through.

1. Set aside a time each day to spend a few minutes in God's Word. It is probably healthy to do it at the same time and place.
2. If you are make New Year's Resolutions, make one to stick with the plan this year. If you have tried and never accomplished reading God's Word in a year, make it a goal and a priority for 2015. We all need the Word in our lives.
3. Don't get stressed if you miss a day or a few days. If you get behind, rather than quit, check the schedule and pick up where we are reading for that day.
4. Chose a translation that is easy to understand. It is good sometimes to read from a translation you are not used to reading. For instance, if you read the NIV most of the time, try reading from the ESV or NKJV for a different sound and understanding.
5. No matter what, take time to spend in God's Word. Reading His Word and hearing His heart through it is vital for our Spiritual health. It is also critical for the spiritual growth of First Baptist Church of Tupelo.
